C. Important Note

- Parents can only apply in case of minor ("minor" as per the provisions of the Indian Majority Act, 1875)
- In case of minor, parent's Address proof has to be appended. The ID proof has to be of minor.
- Beneficiary's/Parent'sself-attested copy of the original document to be produced while applying at Citizen Service Centre (CSC)and if applying online then document are to be uploaded in e-District application software. Physical verification of some documents may be necessary at the counter even in case of online applications.
- Scanned copy of Self-Declaration has to be uploaded while applying online and self-declaration has to be submitted to the concerned SDM/Tehsildar/CSC by hand or speedpost/registered post along with Application /Acknowledgement number.
- The beneficiary himself/herself /any of his family member should be present at the CSC for photograph orsubmit his/her photograph. In case of online application, applicant must upload beneficiary photograph (As per specifications above)
- Details of all the persons to whom certificate has been issued will be put in the public domain and legal action will be taken against those applicants who have been issued SC/ST certificate by furnishing wrong information as per Section 177, 199 and 193 of IPC.
